Begins with a fresh breeze from E & the ship lying to Anchor in Port Prais employed in Sunday jobs about the ship sent boat watch on liberty a labour steamer came in. Middle & Latta part sailing more moderate turned up West Boat and painted her

Friday, Feb. 6, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E & the ship lying to Anchor in Port Prais St. Jago. The Captain bought a lot of iron poles at Auction sent a Boat and got them. Captain Rippley took Thomas Jones out of jail and sent him on Board

Saturday Feb. 7, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from E & the ship lying to Anchor in Port Prais St. Jago. Employed in Righting things generally for sea. A Podzee steamer came in and left again. Bringing the West or English Mail. Middle & Latta part the same several coasting vessels passing in and out Thus ends the Day

Sunday Feb 8 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E & the ship lying to Anchor in Port Prais St. Jago employed in taking on Board Recruits &c Middle & Latta part a fresh breeze from the same sent Boat in and got those that was on shore Thus ends the Day

Monday, Feb. 9, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E & the ship lying to Anchor in Port Prais St. Jago. Middle part moderate Latta part a strong breeze from the same Took on Board Recruits A German Bark and 2 B. Com. well went out Thus ends the Day

Tuesday Feb. 10, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze from N. E. & the ship lying to Anchor in Port Prais St. Jago. Raising up things for sea

The Captain shipped 2 men by the of Marcellus. Lopes Cristian Gomes Middle & Latta part quite moderate Took on Board Recruits and cabin stores and stowed off the Hold all ready for a start Thus ends the Day
