

Wednesday March 11, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E to the ship under short sail steering NW by W employed in painting under the sealing of Cabaret Boat at 3 o'clock finished and put the sealing back Middle & Latta put a strong breeze from E and Key rigged employed in breaking out meat Mrs ends the Day

Latitude 11.34 N
Longitude 37.45 W
Thursday March 12, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze from E the ship under short sail steering NW by W employed in stowing off main hold the Middle & Latta part rather more moderate sett up Fly Gib Gueyes split the fore sail lower it down and repaired it also kept off NW by S Mrs ends the Day

Latitude 12.28 N
Longitude 39.59 W
Friday March 13, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from N by E with heavy sea the ship under stagsails steering NW by S employed in repairing the fore sail finished and sett it at 4 o'clock A M luffed by the wind heading N and took in Gib Middle part a brisk breeze from N by E the ship heading from N by E Latta part much the same at daylight sett Gib and kept off NW by N Pointed the top of the house Mrs ends the Day

Saturday March 14, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from E to the ship under short sail steering SW employed in sundry jobs about the ship at 3 o'clock A M A Dodge man Forward by the Name of Thomas Rascal Breaches on Port Bough 4 P.M. a long way off made sail and luffed for it did not see it again at sunset shorted sail heading E to Middle & Latta part a fresh breeze from the same way ship at 12 o'clock heading NW by N at daylight sett Gib broke out for water Mrs ends the Day

Latitude 13.33 N
Longitude 40.52 W
Sunday March 15, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E to the ship under easy sail heading SE employed in sundry jobs about ship at sunset took in Gib Middle & Latta part a strong breeze from E to E the ship at 12 o'clock of Middle part heading N by E

2 Foremast Hands got Fighting Manuel Lopes and Madson Freeman put Manuel Lopes in irons sett Gib Mrs ends the Day

Latitude 13.29 N
Longitude 40.14 W
Monday March 16, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze from E to the ship under short sail heading N by E at sunset wore ship and took in Gib heading SE

Took Manuel Lopes out of irons Middle & Latta part a very strong breeze from the same way ship at 3 o'clock of Middle part heading N by E at 9 o'clock P M sett Gib and kept off NW Mrs ends the Day
