

Tuesday, March, 17, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from ENE the sea roggel the ship, under short sail steering NW by N employed in breaking out flower etc at sunset took in jib and wore ship, heading SE Middle part the same wore ship at 3 o'clock heading NW at daylight sett jib and keep off NW by N one sail in sight thus ends the day

Wednesday, March, 18, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from E the ship under short sail steering NW by N employed in sundry jobs about the ship, at 1 o'clock AM keep the ship on at sunset took in jib and luffed by the wind heading SE at 3 o'clock of Middle part wore ship heading NW Latter part a strong breeze and squally at daylight sett jib and keep off NW thus ends the day

Longitude 41° 54' W

Thursday, March, 19, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze from E the weather squally the ship under short sail steering NW at 12 past 12 AM wore ship, steady set one sail in sight steering NW at sunset took in jib and luffed by the wind heading SSE Middle & Latter part a strong breeze from the same wore ship at 3 o'clock and at 12 o'clock P.M. heading NW on starboard tack and set by E on Port Tack a very roggel sea and thus ends the day

Longitude 41° 44' W

Friday, March, 20, 1885

Begins with a very strong breeze from ENE the sea roggel the ship under short sail heading SE by E employed in sundry jobs about the ship at sunset took in jib Middle & Latter part blowing strong from the same made no sail wore ship at 3 o'clock heading SE and at 12 o'clock PM heading SE Broke out molasses water and Rice and Pease filled cask with salt water thus ends the day

Longitude 41° 17' W

Saturday, March, 21, 1885

Begins with a very strong breeze from ENE the ship under short sail heading SE employed in a running off main Healeh etc Middle part rather more moderate - wore ship at 3 o'clock heading NW Latter part blowing strong with heavy sea thus ends the day

Latitude 13° 59' N

Longitude 41° 07' W

Sunday, March, 22, 1885

Begins with a very strong breeze from ENE the weather squally with heavy sea the ship under short sail heading SE by E at half past 3 AM wore ship heading SE Middle & Latter part the same wore ship at 3 o'clock heading NW and at 12 PM heading SE by E thus ends the day

Latitude 14° 01' N

Longitude 41° 04' W
