

Monday, March 30, 1885.

Began with a moderate breeze from E to E N E the ship under full sail and main topsail steering NW at sunset wore ship heading SE and took in jib Middle & Latta part the wind and with the much the same wore ship at 4 o'clock heading NE by N at 7 o'clock P M Back the ship off NW by N and set the jib see a piece of squid thus ends the day

Tuesday, March 31, 1885

Began with a moderate breeze from E with quite a back sea the ship under short sail steering NW by N at half past 12 A M wore ship steering SW at sunset took in jib and wore ship by ring aback heading to NE Middle & Latta part a fresh breeze from the same at daylight set jib and kept off NW by N see squid and a school of Blackfish thus ends the day

Wednesday, April 1, 1885

Began with a moderate breeze from E the weather clear the ship under short sail steering NW by N at half past 12 o'clock A M wore ship steering SW at sunset took in jib and luffed two aback heading SE Middle part quite moderate wore ship at 4 o'clock Latta part a strong breeze from the same set jib steering by the wind heading NE Broke out weather also Broke out both sides for Port but found none thus ends the day

Latitude 13° 26' N Longitude 41° 58' W

Thursday, April 2, 1885

Began with a strong breeze from E the ship under short sail heading NW & employed in slowing of main Head to E at 3 o'clock A M wore ship steering SW at sunset luffed to the wind aback heading SE and took in jib Middle & Latta part a fresh breeze from the same wore ship at 4 o'clock at daylight drew away the staysail heading NE thus ends the day

Latitude 13° 18' N
Longitude 43° 01' W
Friday, April 3, 1885

Began with a moderate breeze from E to ESE the ship under full sail jibs and main topsail wore ship at half past 1 A M steering SW at sunset luffed two aback heading SE took in jib Middle & Latta part a strong breeze with heavy sea wore ship at 4 o'clock lying aback at daylight drew away heading NE by N Broke out the run for soapstone thus ends the day

Latitude 13° 04' N
Longitude 44° 16' W
Saturday, April 4, 1885

Began with a strong breeze from E the ship under short sail heading NE by N at 4 o'clock A M wore ship heading SE by S Middle & Latta part a strong breeze wore ship at 4 o'clock heading NE the weather squally at 7 P M set jib thus ends the day
