

Thursday, April, 30, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E to ENE. The weather thick. The ship under fore sail, jibs and main topsail heading NW employed in laying down masts and making sundown one sail in sight at 4 o'clock. At 10 o'clock ship heading SE by S Middle & Leath put a fresh breeze. Wore ship at 12 o'clock heading from N to NNE. Set the jibs. Wore ship at 11 o'clock. The heading or steering SE. Thus ends the day.

Friday, May, 1, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E to ENE. The weather cloudy. The ship under fore sail, jibs and main topsail steering SE. 2 sails in sight. Cleared the spruyer-meechen and hauled at sunset took on jibs luffed by the wind heading SE Middle. Part much the same. Wore ship at 4 o'clock heading from N to NNE. Leath put the wind very light set the jibs. Lowered down fore sail and repaired blocks. Thus ends the day.

Saturday, May, 2, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from E to ENE. The weather clear. The ship under fore sail, jibs and main topsail steering NW employed in making sundown. At 5 o'clock wore ship heading SE by S. At sunset shortened sail. Middle part a calm until 4 o'clock when wore ship heading NW. At daylight made sail and kept off NW. Broke out bread. No basses. Thus ends the day.

Latitude 13.26 N Longitude 40.58 W

Sunday, May, 3, 1885

Begins with light breeze from E to ENE. The weather fine. The ship under all sail steering NW employed in showing off main head. At 1 o'clock AM kept the ship. At sunset shortened sail luffed by the wind heading SE Middle. Leath put moderate breeze from ESE. Wore ship at 11 o'clock heading N by N. At daylight made sail and kept off N. 2 sails in sight. Thus ends the day.

Latitude 13.21 N
Longitude 41.16 W

Monday, May, 4, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from ESE. The ship under all sail steering N. At 2 o'clock AM spoke quick. Gained with the Bro. Rosey Baker. Capt Winslow 6 months out. Cleared. Kept off NW by N. At sunset quick. Gained until short. Next sail and kept off the same course. Middle & Leath part quite a brisk breeze from E by S. The course NW by N employed in making spruyer & the two ends the day.

Latitude 13.52 N
Longitude 42.44 W

Tuesday, May, 5, 1885

Begins with a light breeze from ESE. The weather fine. The ship under short sail steering NW employed in making spruyer. At 6 o'clock AM the gale over changed the course to NW by N. Middle part wore ship at 4 o'clock. At daylight made sail. Kept off NW by N. At 10 o'clock saw fine sail. Wore ship steering NW. Thus ends the day.
