

Sunday, May 10, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from S by E quite a rogged sea and flying by a whale cutting at 3 o'clock A.M. got through cutting and cleared up decks and cleared away the junks and wore ship steering S with main sail and jibs out got snappers and sett by watches Middle & Latta put a fresh breeze from the same steered S until daylight then wore ship heading N by E to the Blaber and opened the cases and started the try works thus ends the Day

Monday, May 11, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from E to ESE the ship made main sail and jibs heading NE at half past 12. A.M. Tacked ship steering S by E employed in Boiling. Middle & Latta put the wind the same wore ship at 4 o'clock heading NE by N and again at 12 P.M. steering SSE thus ends the Day

Tuesday, May 12, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze from ESE the ship made main sail and jibs steering SSE employed in Boiling at 6 o'clock A.M. finished Boiling and got on the Flat Log the 3 Whales turning up 30 lbs Middle & Latta put the wind the same Tack ship at 4 o'clock heading NE and again at 9 o'clock steering SSE made all sail employed in skinning fat leanail the Captain making over a smoke pipe thus ends the Day

Latitude 13.28 Long 14.40

Wednesday, May 13, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from E to ESE the ship made all sail heading or steering SSE employed in Boiling out Folger at 3 A.M. wore ship steering NW by W at sunset shortened sail and wore ship heading S by E Middle & Latta put a fresh breeze from the same wore ship at 4 o'clock heading NW at 7 o'clock P.M. Reck of NW employed in Boiling out and steaming. Jam oil at 11 o'clock got through the 3 Whales showed down 25 lbs thus ends the Day

Thursday, May 14, 1885

Begins with a moderate breeze from E to ESE the ship made short sail steering NW employed in skinning off. Fore and main Healer one sail in sight at 3 A.M. finished at 2 A.M. wore ship to the SE see some fish Middle & Latta put the wind the same wore ship at 4 o'clock heading NE by N at daylight made sail put new mauls Towline on the s'aboard and waist boats lines also Rove New Boat falls Forward on each Boat Tacked ship at 12 P.M. steering S thus ends the Day

Friday, May 15, 1885

Begins with light breeze from ESE the ship made all sail steering SSE at sunset shortened sail Middle & Latta put the wind much the same wore ship at 4 o'clock heading NE made all sail Tacked ship at 12 P.M. steering SSE thus ends the Day
