Began with a fresh breeze from ESE. The deck under all sail steering N. W. Middle put the same Latta put a light breeze broke out water filled with salt muscled, the Day

Wednesday, June, 17, 1885

Began with a moderate breeze from E to ESE. Clear water the deck under all sail steering NW by N employed in same way jobs about ship Middle & Latta put quite moderate attended with squalls of rain commenced Rattling down Fore Rigger during the night see one steamer thus ends the Day

Thursday, June, 18, 1885

Began with a fresh breeze from E to ESE. The deck under all sail steering NW employed in Rattling down Fore Rigger Middle put the wind died away took in topsails and main sail Latta put it breezed up made all sail steering the same course thus ends the Day

Friday, June, 19, 1885

Began with a fresh breeze from E to ESE. The deck under all sail steering NW employed in Rattling down Fore Rigger & at 3 o'clock changed course to N by W Middle & Latta put light breeze from S to SE got out the Irish potatoes to cult over & thus ends the Day

Saturday, June, 20, 1885

Began with a light breeze from SE with fine weather the deck under all sail steering N employed in tulling over potatoes and Rattling down finished Bottom at 5 o'clock A. M. Middle & Latta put the wind very light took in topsails and main sail saw plenty porpoises and how fish broke out for water thus ends the Day

Sunday, June, 21, 1885

Began with a light breeze from SE. The weather quite clear the deck under all sail steering N by W Middle & Latta put quite a fresh breeze from the same sighted 2 sailing vessels and a steamship sighted the opposite way thus ends the Day

Monday, June, 22, 1885

Began with light rain from SE. The deck under all sail steering N by W at 4 o'clock A. M. the wind halled out and came in rainy shortened sail fished over the horse NW at sunset luffed by the wind heaving SW by W Middle & Latta put light variable wind from SW to W the storm different tracks the water thick and rainy thus ends the Day
