

Monday, June 29, 1885

Began with a fresh breeze from
NNE with the water smokey. The S. C. H.
under short sail heading NW by N one
steamer in sight also Dolphin
Middell put under the same way ship
at 4 o'clock heading S. Latter part thick
and rainy with thunder. Made no sea
one steamer in sight. This ends the
Day

Latitude 31° 07' N
Longitude 74° 35' W

Tuesday, June 30, 1885

Began with light airs and heavy
swell from N to NNW. The schooner short
sail heading S to SSW one steamer ship
in sight at 5 o'clock A.M. More ship heading
NNW. Middell part the wind much the same
More ship at 4 o'clock Latter part a light
breeze from N by N the ship heading SW by S
Made all sail. This ends the Day

Latitude 30° 28' N
Longitude 74° 44' W

Wednesday, July 1, 1885

Began with light airs from N
The S. C. H. under all sail heading SSW at
4 o'clock A.M. wind hauled out SW. Jacked
ship heading NNW at sunset shortened
sail at 9 o'clock of Middell part the wind
hauled out N by N with a thunder storm and
plenty of rain. The ship luffed into NNW
Latter part a fresh breeze from N came
1 sail in sight. This ends the Day

Latitude 30° 43' N
Longitude 75° 20' W

Thursday, July 2, 1885

Began with a light breeze from
N by N with heavy swell. The S. C. H. under
short sail heading NNW 1 sailing
vessel and 1 steamer in sight. Middell
& Latter part a brisk breeze from E to ESE
the ship heading from NE to N sent in the
rigging and repaired it. Bent it and
hoisted. Sent this ends the Day

Latitude 31° 17' N
Longitude 75° 06' W

Friday, July 3, 1885

Began with a brisk breeze from SE
The S. C. H. under all sail heading SE
The weather thickening up at 5 o'clock
A.M. it breezed on shortened sail see jumper
at sunset more ship heading SSW. Middell
part the same way ship at 12 o'clock heading
SE at 6 o'clock of Latter part the wind hauled
out NE in a squall and rained and blew
on. Broke out weather and calm. Latter
the ship under short sail heading NW. This ends
the Day

Latitude 31° 28' N
Longitude 74° 39' W

Saturday, July 4, 1885

Began with a fresh breeze from
N to NNE. The S. C. H. under short sail heading
E to ENE at 2 o'clock. Rep. off E and set off
one steamer in sight. Middell & Latter
part a calm luffed close the sails imploded
in painting out side of ship 2 schooners
and 1 steamer in sight. This ends
the Day

Longitude 74° 56' W
