Begins with a strong breeze from
 N. E. The schooner under short sail
 steering N. W. employed in scrubbing the
 inside of the work to paint several
 merchant schooners in sight at sunset
 took in jib luffed by the wind heading
 N. W. Middle part a bar at 8 o'clock
 of latter part there spring up a light breeze
 from N. E. made sail steady N. W. Both
 Capt. McCallister and Flair also finished
 scrubbing ship 2 sails in sight this and the
 day

Friday, Aug. 21, 1885

Begins with a light breeze from
 N. E. The schooner under lower sails
 steering N. W. 3 sails in sight at 5 A. M.
 Gained with Brig Rosey Baker at
 sunset shortened sail it being apparent
 a bar Middle part the same & after
 part a moderate breeze from N. E. made
 sail steady N. W. employed in painting ship
 inside several sails in sight. Ends the
 day

Saturday, Aug. 22, 1885

Begins with a fresh breeze from
 S. E. The schooner under all sail
 steering E. N. E. employed in painting ship in
 sight 2 sails in sight at sunset shortened
 sail luffed by the wind heading S. E. the
 wind heading to S. W. Middle & latter part
 a strong breeze from the same Middle part
 the ship heading S. E. at daylight now ship
 heading N. E. and set jib. Painted water
 ways / masts & 2 masts the day

Sunday, Aug. 23, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze from
 S. W. The schooner under short sail
 heading N. W. employed in painting
 sundry things at sunset Ripped Foresail
 Middle & latter part a strong breeze
 from the same heading much the same
 at daylight set Ripped and set
 jib 2 sails in sight. Ends the
 day

Monday, Aug. 24, 1885

Begins with a strong breeze
 from S. W. The schooner under short sail
 heading N. W. 3 schooners 2 steamers
 in sight at sunset now ship and
 took in jib also Ripped the Foresail
 heading S. E. by 9 Middle & latter part
 a strong breeze from S. W. at daylight set
 jib set Ripped and the Foresail heading S. E.
 3 sails in sight. Ends the day

Tuesday, Aug. 25, 1885

Begins with a red strong breeze
 from S. W. The schooner under short sail heading S. E. 2
 sails in sight see a school of Killers
 at sunset now ship heading N. W.
 and shortened sail Middle & latter
 part blowing strong from the same set
 jib set Ripped and now ship 4 o'clock heading
 S. E. Ends the day
