Saw porpoises and Grampuses and caught more small fish. Headed S by the wind. Wind N. S. W. Land on the lee bow. Caught nearly 3000 small fish by lowering the S. B.

Standing S. W. by W. toward the Id of Fayal and Pico. Saw Grampuse. Off land on Pico Rough and cloudy.

Remarks Saturday July 30<sup>th</sup>.

Rough and rainy Saw Grampuses Off and on Fayal.

Lat 38.50 Long 28.25

Remarks Sunday July 31<sup>st</sup>.

Fresh breeze and heavy sea. Saw long whale off lee bow. Saw S. B. sail and Grampus. Land Dist. about 11 M.

Remarks Monday August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Beating in towards Pico and Fayal Light airs and baffling

Land Dist. 30 M.

Remarks Tuesday August 2<sup>d</sup>.

Lowered S. B. and went ashore Lighter was along side a ten O. clock A. M. Strong tide and baffling winds

Land Dist 4 M.

Remarks Wednesday Aug. 3<sup>d</sup>.

Light airs and drifting with the tide toward St. Georges Lighter came along side with provisions about ten A. M.

## Off the Western Isl.

Remarks Thursday Aug. 4<sup>th</sup> 1870.

Went ashore in S. B. Let sail from the islands at five P. M.

Lat 38.13

Remarks Friday Aug. 5<sup>th</sup>.

Fresh breeze and cloudy Saw Grampuses. Saw dolphin. A swell from Eastward and calm.

Remarks Saturday Aug 6<sup>th</sup>.

Course N. E. by E. Employed clearing between decks and cutting a south to fore hatch. Fresh breeze and pleasant. In sight of Pico.

Lat 38.18 Long 27.07

Remarks Sunday Aug 7<sup>th</sup>.

Headed N. E. by E. by wind of and on Thesyria observed Grampuses and sail.

Land Dist 4 M.

Remarks Monday Aug 8<sup>th</sup>.

Saw blow caused by Devil fish or some thing else of the kind.

Lat 38.18.

Remarks Tuesday Aug 9<sup>th</sup>.

Lowered for Grampuses and gained the H. Albert Lawrence. Capt. Cleaveland Fair. Heaven. Passed more land. Fresh breeze and pleasant. Headed S by the wind.
