Remarks Wednesday Dec 14th 1870.
Begins with baffling winds from N.
W. N. W. to S. W. and light squalls.
Middle part moderate between squalls.
Lat 58-19 Long 68-50

Remarks Thursday Dec 15th
Light airs from the eastward but
hauling to the S. all sail set.
Middle part baffling and squally
a heavy head swell Weather very
fine

Lat 57-53 Long 69-10

Remarks Friday Dec 16th.
Begins with a light wind from
the N. N. W. hauled as far as
the N. N. E. Two sails in company.
Latter part calm and head swell
Saw two Fin-backs and Grampiose

Lat 57-45 Long 69-19

Remarks Saturday Dec 17th.
Begins with a calm At 2 1/2 P. M.
with a light breeze from the N. N. E.
a head sea The wind slowly increas-
ing and hauling to the E. At 8 P. M.
wind E. N. E. Course W. by S.
The same two sails in company.
Barometer 29 1/4 100. Middle part rainy
strong winds Latter part fresh
gales from the E and rainy
At 7 P. M. changed the course to
W. Under main top sail and
main top gall sail. Double fore top
and fore sail

Lat 57-01 Long 75-00

Remarks Sunday Dec 17th.
Fresh gale from E. and rainy.

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Course W. at 3 P. M. changed the
course to W. by N. Latter part
fresh breezes from the E but slowly
hauling to the S. Course N. W.
Lat 55-34 Long 78-45

Remarks Monday Dec 19th.
anoderate breeze from the S
and slowly hauling to westward
Course N. W. by W. all sail set
three sails in sight
Caught a porpoise. Latter part
wind W. Weather thick and
rainy. Passed the Forrest King
Bark.

Lat 54-22 Long 78-47

Remarks Tuesday 20th Dec.
Begins with strong winds from
the W and rainy at 6 P. M. wind
W. N. W. Saw a big under very
heavy sail. Middle part rainy
and thick wind the same

Lat 54-29. No Long

Remarks Wednesday 21st Dec.
Strong winds from N. W. by W.
Weather thick and damp.
Heaving S. W. by W. under
double reefed main top sail and
an close reefed fore. and reefed
courses. Saw a sail. Trying to
get where we are. Latter better
weather and more moderate.

Lat 54-52 Long 80-42

Remarks Thursday Dec 22^d.
Windy from the N. W. by W.
Heaving S. W. by W.
Barometer falling shows either
more wind or rain.
