Saw a Steamer Sat. 23-25 Long 71.00

Remarks Tuesday July 18th 1871

Begins with a light wind from the S. S. E.
Steering W. by S. At sundown the wind died out shortened sail. Martha to the leeward. Latter part wind from the S. S. E. and strong.

Remarks Wednesday July 19th 1871

Begins with a strong wind from the S. S. E.
Heaving to the E. At 4 P. M. wore ship and at sundown shortened sail.
Saw Blackfish. Lat.

Remarks Thursday July 20th 1871.

Begins with moderate gale from the S. S. E.
Heaving to the S. W. cloudy.
Latter part the same. Saw Blackfish.
Lat 23-33.

Remarks Wednesday July 21st

Begins with a moderate gale from the S. S. E.
Heaving S. W. Latter part the same.
Lat. 23-44 Long 74.00

Remarks Thursday July 22^d.

Begins with a strong breeze from the S. S. E.
Course S. W. Latter part the same.

Begins with a light breeze from the S. S. E.
and a heavy swell. Course S. W. by W.
Latter part strong breeze from S. S. E.
and squally
Sat. 23-54.

Remarks Monday July 24th

Begins with a strong breeze from the S. S. E. Course S. W.
Latter part the same.

Sat 24-44 Long 77-23.

Remarks Tuesday July 25th

Begins with a strong breeze from the S. E. Under double reef courses and spanker. Course S. S. W.
Finished my first piece of scrimshaw.
Latter part the same.
Sat. 25-14 Long 18-15.

Remarks Wednesday July 26th

Begins with a strong wind from the S. E. Course S. S. W.
Latter part light wind from the S. S. E.
fore & under. Fore sail double reefed.
fore-top sail. maintop mast staysail.
main-top sail and spanker
Lat. 25-42 Long 78-57

Remarks Thursday July 27th

Begins with a light wind from the S. S. E. Course S. W. by S.
Saw a Humpback. Latter part calm.
