Remarks Thursday Aug 17th
Begins with a fresh breeze from the
S. W. Heading S. E. by E. At
midnight shortened sail. Latter part head-
ing to the S. E. wind from the W.
Lat 34-32 Long 76-02

Remarks Friday Aug 18th
Begins with a strong breeze from the W.
Steering S. S. W. Saw a large piece
of squid. At midnight wore ship and
shortened sail. Heading to the N. N. W.
Lat 34-28 Long 75-50

Remarks Saturday Aug 19th
Begins with very light air from the
S. W. with a heavy sea. Heading
to the N. W. by W. Saw sail.
Latter part mod. gale from the S. W. by W.
Heading S. W. by S.
Lat 34-22 Long 75-36

Remarks Sunday Aug 20th
Begins with a moderate gale from the
S. W. by W. Headed N. N. W.
Under close reefed main top sail
and stay sail. Latter moderating
with a heavy swell. Lat 33-59 Long 76-16.

Begins with a light wind from the S. S. E.
Steering S. W. heavy sea.
Latter part wind from the S. W.
by W. Heading to the S. S. E.

Begins with a strong wind from
the S. Heading to the E. S. E.
Latter part wind from the S. E.
Heading to the E. S. E.
Lat 34-44 Long 75-08

Remarks Wednesday Aug 23^d
Begins with the wind from the S. S. E.
Heading W. S. W. Caught two
right whale porpoises. Latter part mod.
gale from the S. S. W. Heading
S. W. by W.
Lat 34-03 Long

Remarks Thursday Aug 24th
Begins with a moderate gale from
the S. S. E. Heading to the S. W.
by W. Latter part the same
Lat 33-43 Long 75-40

Remarks Friday Aug 25th
Begins with a strong wind from
the S. by E. Heading S. W. by W.
Latter part wind from S.
E. Heading to the E. S. E.
Moderating fast.
Lat 33-22. Long
