 Remarks Monday Oct. 2d. 1871
 Begins with a light wind from the S.
 Heading W. S. W. Employed boiling
 Latter part wind from the S. and strong
 Cooled down during the night Lat 35-45 Long 74-21

Remarks Tuesday Oct 3d. 1871.
 Begins with a strong wind from the S.
 Heading E. S. E. At sunset wore ship
 heading W. S. W. Martha in sight to
 leeward. Latter part strong wind from the S.
 Lat. 35-41 Long 74-25

Remarks Wednesday Oct 4th
 Begins with a strong wind from the S. Headed to
 the E. S. E. At midnight wore ship heading
 W. S. W. Latter part wind from the S.
 Heading W. S. W. At seven A.M.
 raised whales to windward. Lowered all four
 boats. But the whales got galled somehow and
 we could not fasten as they were going to windward
 At 1 P.M. the boats came along side
 Lat 35-39 Long 74-02

Remarks Thursday Oct 5th.
 Begins with a light wind from the S. Heading
 W. S. W. At sunset very light wind almost
 calm. Latter part wind from the W. S. W.
 Heading S. Lat 35-32 Long No Obs

Remarks Friday Oct 6th
 Begins with a light wind from the W. S. W.
 and light. Heading S. At 2 1/2 P.M.
 raised whales to leeward going quick to windward
 The Martha lowered three boats in chase. We
 lowered all four boats the Lar. W. and Bow boats
 fastened the Lar. boats line parted and they lost
 the whale. At 4 1/4 P.M. took one of the whales
 along-side. At 5 1/2 P.M. took the other
 one along-side.

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 Remarks Cont. Friday Oct 6th 1871
 The Martha in sight Latter part wind from
 the N. W. Head to and cutting commenced cutting
 at 5 1/2 A.M. Got one in at 8 1/2 and the other
 in at 11. Wind shifted to the S. W.
 Lat. 35-36 Long No Obs

Remarks Saturday Oct 7th
 Begins with a fresh breeze from the S. E. by S
 Heading S. W. by S. Employed clearing away
 the head. At 4 o'clock started the works
 Caught a Porpoise. Latter part strong wind from
 S. S. E. Heading E. Boiling
 Lat. 35-36 Long 74-22

Remarks Sunday Oct 8th.
 Begins with a strong wind from the S. S. E.
 Heading to the E. Employed Boiling.
 Latter part strong wind from the S. S. E.
 Heading S. W. Lat 35-13 Long 74-02

Remarks Monday Oct 9th
 Begins with a strong wind from the S. by E
 Heading S. W. by W. Employed Boiling
 Latter part moderating slowly. Cooled down
 during the night Commenced again at 7 in
 the morning
 Lat 35-46 Long No Obs

Remarks Tuesday Oct 10th
 Begins with a strong wind from the S. by E.
 Heading E. by S. Employed Boiling
 and storing down. Latter part wind from
 N. W. Heading S. Lat Long No Obs.

Remarks Wednesday Oct 11th.
 Begins with a light wind from the N. W.
 Heavy swell from the S. Heading to the
 S. Scrambling ship. The whale stored down
 84 bbls. Latter part wind from the
 S. S. W. and baffling Heading S. E.
 Lat 34-32 Long 73. 51
