Tuesday October 13th 1885

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from N.E. Sch on S. Sack. at 1 A.M. Sacked to S.W. by N. Latter Part. Light Winds from W. to N.W. at 4.30 P.M. Sacked to N.W. Lat. 37.15 N. Long. 75.36 W.

Wednesday Oct 14th

These 24 Hours comes in with fresh Winds and squally. at 1 A.M. Handed the Hurricane and Flying Jib. Got out Reef. Park. and Water at 11 A.M. Sacked to N.W. Winds N.W. Latter Part. Light Winds from N.W. Sch on S.W. Sack. Saw 1 Macore Dolphin and broken Squid Lat. 30.31 N. Long. 75.40 W.

Thursday Oct 15th

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from N.W. by N. Sch on W. Sack. at 6.30 A.M. Lowered the Boats for sperm Whales going slow to Windward. L.B. got one. J.B. got one. Latter Part. L.B. and W.B. Chasing at 5 P.M. boats got on board. got ready for butting. Lat. 30.25 N. Long. 76.30 W.

Friday Oct 16th

These 24 Hours comes in with fine weather and light air from N.E. but in the Whales. Latter Part. Winds and weather the same at 1 P.M. Wore Ship. at 5 P.M. Started Boiling. Lat. 29.40 N. Long. 75.51 W.

Saturday Oct 17th

These 24 Hours comes in with light Winds from N.E. Sch on E. Sack boiling at 8 A.M. Wore Ship. & N.W. Stowed down the Head Oil. Saw White Water at dinner & times saw no more of it. Saw 3 three Masted Sch Staring N.W. at 10 P.M. Finished Boiling Lat. 29.38 N. Long. 75.38 W.

Sunday October 18th

These 24 Hours comes in with fine weather and light Winds from N.E. Sch on N.W. Sack. Stowed down the Oil. Saw two steamers. Latter Part. Winds and weather the same saw Porpoises. at sunset Thor land Sail. Lat. 29.44 N. Long. 75.52 W.

Monday Oct 19th

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from E. Sch on N.W. Sack. Saw blackfish. Latter Part. light Winds. Sch Staring N. at 4 P.M. Staring W. S.W. Saw two steamers. & Dark Shorten Sail Hauled by the Wind on S. Sack. Lat. 30.30 N. Long. 76.33 W.

Tuesday Oct 20th

These 24 Hours comes in with fine weather and light Winds from S.E. Sch on S. Sack. saw a Bark Staring N.W. Saw Porpoises. got out Block broke out the rim and stowed soap and carried Goods in cask. Latter Part Winds the same & saw Back Sch Staring N.W. at sunset Shortened sail Hauled by the Wind on N.W. Sack. Lat. 30.31 N. Long. 77.38 W.

Wednesday Oct 21st

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from S.E. Sch on E. Sack. at 7 A.M. Staring E. Latter Part. light Winds from S.W. at 3 P.M. Had a light squel from N.W. Saw a Sch. Staring N.W. Ends with light air from N.W. and fine Rain. Hauled by the Wind on N. Sack Lat. 30.25 N. Long. 77.19 W.

Thursday Oct 22nd

These 24 Hours comes in with Squally weather and light Winds from N.W. at 6.30 A.M. Wore Ship Staring E. Haul all sail. Panited the low Spirit. Latter Part. Squally Rainy weather and fresh Winds from N.W. E. at 4.30 P.M. saw Sprats and small White. run for it but did not make it out before Dark. Shortened sail. Lat. 30.30 N. Long. 76.10 W.
