Wednesday February 17th 1856.

These 24 Hours comes in With fresh Winds from S. Sch Steering S.E. by E. Said I Embark Saw two Sails. Latter Part. more Moderate. Sch Steering S.E. by E. Wind S. by W. Lat. 31. 45 N. Long. 61. 33 W.

Thursday Feb 18th

These 24 Hours comes in With strong Winds from S.W. Sch Steering S.E. by E. With all Sail set. Saw two Humpbacks. at 10 A.M. Steering S.E. by E. Latter Part. Winds S.W. Saw a Sail on W. Back. Lat. 31. 10 N. Long 57. 59 W. got out Water.

Friday Feb 19th

These 24 Hours comes in With fresh Winds from W. Sch Steering S.E. by E. Eatst Bread. Dried Apples. Beans. Molasses. Opened the Strep. Cask. Latter Part. More Moderate. Stowed Brok. Porpoises Came under but got none. Lat. 30. 14 N. Long. 54. 53 W.

Saturday Feb 20th

These 24 Hours comes in With light Winds from W. and Squally. Sch Steering S.E. by E. Saut 4 Dolphins. Latter Part. Moderate Winds from S.W. Sch Steering S.E. by E. With all Sail set. Lat. 29. 27 N. Long. 52. 40 W.

Sunday February 21st

These 24 Hours comes in With strong Winds from S.W. by W. Sch Steering S.E. by E. Latter Part. More Moderate. Sch Steering S.E. by E. at 6 P.M. Steering S.E. & S. Winds S.W. Lat. 28. 31 N. Long. 49. 10 W.

Monday Feb 22nd

These 24 Hours comes in With light Winds from S.W. Sch Steering S.E. by S. Latter Part. light airs and calms. Lat. 27. 10 N. Long. 46. 59 W.

Tuesday Feb. 23rd

These 24 Hours comes in With light Winds from W.S.W. Sch Steering S.E. by S. said I Ship Steering to N.E. Set up the Martingil Gills. bowsprit Sails. and Port Flying Jib lower Gills. Latter Part. Moderate Wind from W.S.W. Sch Steering S.E. put out the after Sail to cutting Stage. said I Ship steering to N.E. Saw two Humpbacks. Lat. 26. 22 N. Long. 45. 53 W. got out Water.

Wednesday Feb 24th

These 24 Hours comes in With moderate Winds from W.S.W. Sch Steering S.S.E. Saw I Embark. at Work over hauling the Windlass Gear. Saw Black fish. Saw a Sail. Latter Part. Winds the same. Lat. 24. 43 N. Long. 44. 16 W.

Thursday Feb 25th

These 24 Hours comes in With light Winds and Squally Weather from S.W. Sch Steering S.E. Employed cleaning Iron Work. and Scraping fore Boom. Flying Jib Sheaf & Ported Latter Part. strong Winds from S.W. to S.S.W. Sch on S.S.E. Sack. Handed the Fore Top Sail. Saw Porpoises. Lat. 22. 49 N. Long. 42. 09 W.

Friday Feb 26th

These 24 Hours comes in With Moderate Winds from S.W. to W. and Squally. Sch Steering S.E. Latter Part the same Sch Steering S.W. by E. & E. Saw a Merchant Bark by the Wind on Starboard Back. Lat. 21. 31 N. Long. 40. 50 W.

Saturday Feb 27th

These 24 Hours light huffing airs and calms With Rain Squalls. Sch Steering to S.E. Saw a Bark to W. got out Flour Molasses and Rice. Lat. 21. 23 N. Long. 40. 07 W.
