Saturday April 10th

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Trades from E. N. E. Sch on S. E. Sack. at Daylight Saw Black Fish going quick to Leeward. at Sunrise wore Ship to N. N. E. got out Water Beans Dried Apples and Coffee. Saw A Barkentine Steaming to W. Latter Part Squally. Saw Porpoises. Saw White Water And Spouts. Called it Humpback. at Sunset Shortened Sail. Sch on N. Sack. Lat. 11.59 N. Long. 42.49 W.

Sunday April 11th

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds and Fine Weather. Sch on S. E. Sack. at 6.30 A. M. wore Ship to N. N. E. Latter Part Winds and Weather the same. Took A Lunar Observation at Sunset wore Ship to S. E. Lat. 12.51 N. Long. 43.00 W.

Monday April 12th

These 24 Hours comes in with Fine Weather and Light Winds from E. to N. E. Sch on N. Sack. saw A Grampus. Latter Part Winds and Weather much the same. saw White Water run for it. saw no more of it. Took A Lunar Observation. at Sunset Sch on S. E. Sack. Lat. 13.14 N. Long. 43.14 W.

Tuesday April 13th

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Trades from E. Sch on S. E. Sack. at 6.30 A. M. wore Ship to N. E. by N. Middle and Latter Part. Squally Baring Weather and Variable Winds and Calm. at Sunset Shortened Sail.

Wednesday April 14th

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Trades from E. by S. Sch on N. Sack. saw A Merchant Bark Steaming to W. at 11 A. M. saw A Whaling Sch to Windward. Latter Part. at 1 P. M. Sacked to S. by W. at 4 P. M. Tamed with Sch. with A Frogger two Months and A Half out 50 lbs. Spum. got Whale Lat. 13.42 N. Long. 42.54 W.

Friday April 16th

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Trades from E. by N. to E. S. E. Sch on N. N. E. Sack. the Frogger and A Merchant Bark and Ship in sight. at 7.30 A. M. Sack to N. E. spoke Ship Jessie Readman of Glasgow from New Zealand. His Long 42.30 W. Ours 42.25 W. Latter Part. Winds the same. at 2.30 P. M. Sacked to N. N. E. Cant A Surt. at Sunset Shortened Sail Lat. 13.47 N. Long. 42.25 W.

Saturday April 17th

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from S. E. to E. Sch on S. Sack at 6.30 A. M. wore Ship to N. E. got out Flour Water and Sugar. Latter Part. at 12 45 P. M. saw Spouts. Sacked back and forth but saw no more of it. with A Frogger and A Merchant Bark in sight. at Sunset Shortened Sail Sch on S. Sack. Lat. 14.28 N. Long. 42.26 W.

Sunday April 18th

These 24 Hours comes in with light Trades from S. E. Sch on S. by W. Sack. at 7 A. M. Sch on E. by N. Sack. saw A Sail to Leeward. Latter Part Winds the same at 1 P. M. Sacked to S. S. W. saw Grampuses. at Sunset Shortened Sail. Sch on S. by W. Sack. Lat. 14.08 N. Long. 42.28 W.

Monday April 19th

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Trades from S. E. to E. Sch on S. Sack. at 7 A. M. Steaming S. W. at 10 A. M. Steaming N. W. by W. Latter Part. Winds the same. saw Porpoises. at Sunset Shortened Sail. Hauled by the Wind on N. E. Sack. Lat. 13.32 N. Long. 43.10 W.
