These 24 Hours comes in with Light Trades from E. S. E. to S. E. Sch on S. Sack. at Sunrise Steering W. S. W. Latter Part. Saw Transpures. Sch Steering N. W. at sunset Shortened Sail. Wore Ship. S. E. Fore Stay Sail to Windward. Lat. 13. 34 N. Long. 44. 12 W.

Thursday April 22

Friday April 30

These 24 Hours fresh Trades from E. N. E. at 7 A. M. Wore Ship to N. by E. got out Water and Flour. Saw the Grozier to Windward. Latter Part. Winds the same. at 5 P. M. Wore Ship to S. E. Lat. 12. 56 N. Long. 45. 26 W.
