

Remarks on Board The Sch. Katie E. Smith

Tuesday June 1st 1886

Rigged out the Schooner and set up the Rigging and bent Main Sails. All Hands on Board at 6 P.M. took the Anchor and sailed from Barbados

Wednesday

June 2nd

Came in with squally weather and rain at 9 A.M. Saw Barbados at sunset. Saw Dominica. Hauled the Main sail and Fore Topsail.

Thursday June 3rd

at 11 A.M. Anchored at Prince Rupert Bay in 3 Fathoms Water. got ready to take water. The Brig Fr. A. Barston here

Friday June 4th

at work getting water. Commenced to paint Schoon side. Traded Fish for Fruit Yeans Brown Stup and Sweet Potatoes. this morning the C.W. Moore Anchored.

Saturday June 5th

at work getting water and painting. got half cord Wood.

Sunday June 6th

Put the crew on shore

Monday June 7th

Five Men Missing this morning set up all the Rigging.

Tuesday June 8th

Some Light Rain squalls. one more Man run away. got three Bar Coasts Wood. Painted Port of the Port side. Mended the Masts.

Wednesday June 9th

Came in with a Hard Rain Storm. at Sunrise Fine Weather. Painted the Out Side all but the Iron Work. got more Wood. Loosed and Dried the Sails. kept bad with the Rheumatism.

Thursday June 10th

Employed Painting and Trading Fish for recruits. Went after Dark to find our men didn't get them. Shipped One more man.

Friday June 11th

At Sunrise got our Anchor and got underway Steering N.W. by N. at Dark Montserrat in sight. Ship kept off Duty with a sore Hand.

Saturday June 12th

Fresh Trades Sch. Lying Aback to Seward of St. Christopher. at 8 A.M. sent the Boat on shore at Sandy Point Village. got three Men. at 10.30 on board again. at 11. Passed Orange Town Isl. St. Eustacia. at 7 P.M. saw the Light on Somboro Isl. Shortened sail.

Sunday June 13th

Light Trades Boat the Chronometer off Somboro Isl. found the coming 2. Sec. per Day. Saw a Steamer Steaming S.W. Leather Port. Light Trades from E. to E. by S. Sch on N.E. Track. at Sunset Wind N.E. by E. Sch on N. Track. Lat. 19.04 N. Long 63.16 W.

Monday June 14th

Moderate Trades from E. to E. and squally Sch. Steaming N.E. by E. Mended the Anchors. unbent the chains. at work hoisting the chains. said I sail to Seward. at 11. Part. Winds and Weather the same. Hauled the Main sail. set the Fore sail. No C.S.
