

Remarks On Board The Sch. Katie E. Smith.

Wednesday July 21 1886

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Winds from S.W. Sch. Steaming E. Sent A Boat on board Austrian Brig Bogoria. 31 Days from Martinique. Loaded with Sugar bound to Marseille. Reports very calm weather. His Chronometer four Degrees from ours. Latter Part. Winds the same. Sch. Steaming E. Christo sick with bad cough. raises blood. Saw White Water two and a half Miles off saw no more. Lat. 34. 00 N. of it at sunset Shortened Sail. Hauled D. N. W. Long. 48. 18 W. by W. Back.

Thursday July 22

These 24 Hours comes in with Fresh Winds from S.W. Sch. on W. by N. Back. Saw White Water A Head five Miles off saw no more of it. at 8 A.M. Steaming N. by E. Latter Part. Winds the same. Saw White Water three and a half Miles off saw no more of it. Rose one New England in Port. Steam Boiling. Saw Grampuses. Lat. 34. 55 N. at sunset Haul by the Wind on N. W. by N. Back Long. 47. 52 W.

Friday July 23

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds and fine Rain from S.W. at 7 A.M. Winds W. Sch. Steaming N. W. Latter Part. Winds and course the same. at 6 P.M. Hauled by the Wind on N.W. by N. Back. at sunset Shortened Sail. Lat. 35. 40 N. Long. 48. 32 W.

Saturday July 24

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from W. to W. N. W. Sch. on N. Back. Latter Part. More Wind Weather Hazy. got Out Water. Killed A Pig. Saw broken Squid. Spoke Steamer Grindon of West Hartpool. From Lisbon Steaming N.W. by W. His Long. 49. 10 W. Ours. 49. 20 W. at sunset Shortened Sail. Lat. 36. 37 N. Long. 49. 22 W.

Sunday July 25

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from W. and Rainy weather. Sch. on N. Back. at 7.30. Wore Ship to S. S. W. Saw A Bark Steaming to Eastward. Saw broken Squid Latter Part. Winds the same A Heavy swell from W. Saw broken Squid. at 6 P.M. Steaming N. E. Lat. 37. 00 N. Long. 49. 37 W.

Monday July 26

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Winds from N. S. Sch. Steaming N. E. Latter Part. Winds N. W. Saw Black Fish and A Turtle. Lat. 37. 38 N. Long. 49. 08 W.

Tuesday July 27

These 24 Hours comes in with Light air from S.W. Sch. Steaming N. E. at 8 A.M. Steaming E. N. E. Put A Letter on Board Spanish Steam Whistle Steamer Vasco bound to New York. Saw another Steamer. Caught A Turtle. Latter Part. Light air and calm. Caught Dolphin and A Turtle. Saw Grampuses. at sunset Shortened Sail. Lat. 37. 48 N. Long. 48. 34 W.

Wednesday July 28

These 24 Hours comes in with light air from S. Sch. Steaming E. N. E. Got out Water. Latter Part light Winds from S.W. Saw A Steamer Steaming to W. by N. Saw Spouts. Run for them and one more Spout. Saw no more of it Picked up A Lump of Tallow. Sch. Steaming by the Wind on S. E. Back. at sunset Shortened Sail. Lat. 38. 17 N. Long. 48. 05 W.

Thursday July 29

These 24 Hours comes in with light Winds from S. S. W. Sch. on W. Back. Saw A Sail Steaming E. at 7.30 Backed to S. E. at 10. Backed to W. Latter Part. at 2 P.M. Steaming N. W. Saw A Sail D. N. Picked up A Piece of Wrecked Ship. at sunset Shortened Sail. Hauled by the Wind on W. Back Lat. 37. 56 N. Long. 48. 05 W.
