Wednesday September 22^d 1886

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Winds from S.S.W. Sch on W. Tack. at 7 A.M. Steering N.W. Saw Corpses. Latter Part Winds S.W. Saw Corpses.

Thursday Sept 23

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Winds from S.S.W. Sch Steering N.W. took A Sunner Observation Latter Part. Saw Grampuses. Wind Howled to W. Sch on N.W. by N. Tack.

Long 40° 46' W.

Friday Sept 24

These 24 Hours comes in with Light Winds from N.W. Sch Steering N.W. to N.E. Latter Part Wind S.W. Sch Steering N.W. The Rudder Head Works Very bad

Saturday Sept 25

These 24 Hours comes in with Strong Winds from S.W. Sch on W. Tack. at 3 A.M. Handed the Deck got out Flour Bread Mashed Beans and Water. at 9.50 called the Men from the Mainheads. Close Reaped the Fore-sail. Latter Part. at 1.30 Wore Ship to S.E. by S. Wind Canting to Westward. unbuttoned the Flying Jib. Blowing Fresh and rough Barometer falling. at 7 P.M. Sch Heading S.W. E. The Rudder is in A bad condition.

Sunday Sept 26

These 24 Hours comes in with A Gale from W. S.W. Sch on S. Tack. at 4 A.M. commenced to rain at 5 A.M. Moderating. Latter Part Wore Ship to E. N.E. Wind N. Set the Jib. at 4 P.M. Wind blowing on again from W. at 5.30 Wore Ship to S.W. by S. Wind W. The Rudder Bounds Very Hard on the Stern Post

Monday Sept 27

These 24 Hours comes in with A Gale from S.W. Sch on W. by S. Tack. the Rudder Bounds on the Sternpost Very Hard. at 11 A.M. Found that the Rudder had split partly of from the Rudder Post. Latter Part. at Work rigging A Gear to Steer by Weather more Moderate. at 7 P.M. Steering E. Lost the Main Tutch on board. at Dark Fore and the Head Sails set.

Tuesday Sept 28

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from N.W. to W. Sch Steering E. and E. S. E. Parted the Tack rope to Fore Tapsail. sent it down to Repair. Latter Part. rather more Wind Sch Steering E. S. E. Killed Back the Jib. Bent the Fore Tapsail and set it.

Wednesday Sept 29

These 24 Hours comes in with Moderate Winds from W. Sch Steering E. S. E. Sun A Sail to W. Sch. Latter Part. Weather Squally with Rain. Winds from N.E. to E. Sch on S.E. Tack. Handed the Flying Jib.

Thursday Sept 30

These 24 Hours comes in with Calms and Heavy Squalls of Wind from S.E. to E. S. E. with Rain Sch on Heading from E. S. E. to E. Saw two Sails Steering to Westward. Latter Part Fresh Winds from S.E. Sch on E. S. E. Tack. got out Water.
