

Remarks On Board The Schooner H. C. Smith.

Sunday October 10 1886

These 24 hours comes in with moderate winds from E. and much rain. Schooner S. Tack at 5 A.M. wore ship to N.E. Wind hauled to N.W. blowing fresh. Schooner steering E.S.E. at 10 A.M. steering E.S.E. with foresail and the head sails set. Sailed Port. Moderate and fairing. Wind from W. to W.N.W. at dark clearing up. Lat 38.05 N. Long 29.35 W.

Monday Oct 11

These 24 hours comes in with fresh winds from W. Schooner steering E.S.E. at 6.30 A.M. and the land. Sailed Port. at 3 P.M. Anchored at Sayal. in 13 fathoms. Hauled the U. W. Adams. Delivered the lumber and bark Sarah and Barkentine M.B. Dorrer at anchor here. The Dorrer and S. Thurt sold this day.

Tuesday Oct 12

Fine weather. Hauled up under the Break Water. Moored her. Sailed Port. Whistling out Oil.

Wednesday Oct 13

Fine weather. engaged at trucking out oil. Mr Beebe made visit to hospital.

Thursday Oct 14

Fine weather. Wind moderate from N. Hauled seven casks of oil containing 1823 gallons of the oil. Casks bound to New Bedford.

Friday Oct 15

Fine weather. wind moderate from N. Employed at unloading the rudders. Had to hire a diver to look the rudders. and they found out there was quite a number of shells. copper off her bottom. also engaged at setting up and repairing casks.

Fine weather engaged selling oil casks.

Sunday Oct 17th

Fine weather. One watch ashore on a run.

Monday Oct 18th

Fine weather. Engaged at storing the hold and painting the rudders.

Tuesday Oct 19th

Fine weather. Engaged at storing the hold and other various jobs.

Wednesday Oct 20th

Fine weather. Engaged at getting off 20 Blk. heads and packing it in barrels.

Thursday Oct 21st

Fine weather. Harbored water ashore on a day.

Friday Oct 22nd

Fine weather. engaged at hanging the rudders and divers painting on copper. Port yard ashore on boats. Louis de Koke and Joseph Francis about without leaf.

Saturday Oct 23rd

Fine weather. Divers employed at repairing on copper. Got off one lift water this day.

Sunday Oct 24th

Fine weather. One watch ashore on a run. Louis de Koke and Joe Francis deserted.

Monday Oct 25th

Fine weather. Engaged rafting water.
