squally with hard rains.

Saturday April 9th

Commences with squally weather

molasses. Lat 4:00' South

Long 24:31' West

Sunday April 10th

Light winds and light rains.
Saw 1 sail. Middle and latter part
squally.

Lat 3:28' South
Long 25:02' West

Monday April 11th

Calm and squalls. Saw blackfish.
Middle part squally. Latter part
fine weather. Saw three sails.

Lat 2:15' South
Long 25:43' West

Tuesday April 12th

Fine weather and a fine breeze.
Saw one sail. Middle and
latter part squally.

Lat 0:02' North
Long 26:09' West

Wednesday April 13th

Squalls of rain and fair weather
between. Middle part squally. Latter
part fine. Sent down and repaired the
fore topsail. Lat 1:14' North

Long 26:45' West

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Thursday April 14th

Nearly calm finished and bent fore topsails
Middle and latter part squalls
of rain, and light winds. Saw
two sails. No observation

Friday April 15th

Light winds with rain. Middle
and latter part hard rains. Saw
three sails. Lat 5:17' North

Long 27:33' West

Saturday April 16th

Fine weather with light airs.
Samuel Benox and Walter Nichols
both West India men had a dispute
about some small affair, and
Benox drew a knife and cut Mr
Nichols in the back quite a deep
gash. Middle and latter part
fine weather with moderate N E
trade winds. Saw blackfish.

Long 29:21' West

Sunday April 17th

Wind moderate from the N E.
Saw blackfish. One sail in sight.
Middle and latter part fine weather

Lat 5:28' North
Long 30:44' West

Monday April 18th

Fine weather and moderate trades
Middle and latter part wind much
stronger. Lat 6:38' North

Long 32:34' West

Tuesday April 19th

Very strong trades. Put garboard and
bark boards on upper exanes.
Middle part the same. Latter part
more moderate.

Lat 7:52' North
Long 34:35' West
