Sunday May 22nd

Wind increasing with squalls of rain and quite a combing sea. Reefed laying under reefed foresail. Middle part moderate. Latter part set fifth and 8th jib. Saw nothing worthy of note.

Monday May 23rd

Moderate. Turned reef out of foresail and set reefed mainsail. Middle and latter part very light winds from the west. Broke out a cask of Pork 4 1/2 bbls. Broke out new Saff Topsail. Saw one sail. Lat 32° 02' North

Long 42° 02' West

Tuesday May 24th

Wind increasing and hauling to the north. Put boats on upper crane. Middle and latter part very rough. Bent fore topsail for main jib sail. Saw one Hinback.

Lat 32° 45' North

Long 40° 00' West

Wednesday May 25th

Moderate. Middle part wind increasing. Latter part very rough. Saw Sulphur Bottoms. Lat 33° 40' North

Long 37° 09' West

Thursday May 26th

Wind hauled to the NW and getting smoother water. Middle and latter part lighter winds. Set mainsail.

Lat 34° 10' North

Long 37° 06' West

Friday May 27th

Wind very light from the north. Killed a Pig. Middle part moderate. Latter part strong winds with rain.

Lat 35° 00' North

Long 35° 11' West

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Saturday May 28th

Fair cool weather. Saw Sulphur Bottoms. Middle part moderate. Latter part strong winds with fog and rain. Rugged water. Carried away the iron work to the Port. Martingale guy. Set it up again with a tackle. Saw Hinbacks and Cow fish. Lat 36° 00' North

Long 34° 29' West

Sunday May 29th

Strong winds with rain, fog, and rugged water. Middle and latter part more moderate. Saw Hinbacks and Cow fish. Lat 36° 05' North

Long 33° 23' West

Monday May 30th

Fresh winds from the NE. Middle and latter part the same. Very rugged water. Saw one sail. Lat 35° 29' North

Long 32° 31' West

Tuesday May 31st

Strong winds from the North and rough water. Middle and latter part the same. Lat 36° 55' North

Long 31° 30' West

Wednesday June 1st

Winds strong in squalls and very rugged. Saw Hinbacks. Saw a barrel of Kerosene. Middle and latter part wind strong from the West and very rugged water. Lat 38° 13' North

Long 30° 10' West

Thursday June 2nd

Wind strong from the West with fog squalls. Took in mainsail and 8th jib, and set main jib sail. Saw Porpoises. Middle and latter part strong winds and rain.

Lat 39° 04' North

Long 28° 40' West
