Monday June 13th

Light winds from the North. Saw one sail.
Saw fish, squid, turtle, and drift wood.
Middle and latter part wind light. Saw
Porpoises. Lat 37° 41' North
Long 18° 00' West

Tuesday June 14th

Nearly calm. Saw plenty of fish.
Saw one sail. Middle and latter part
calm, but reef points in down sail. No wind
fore Gaff. Lat 37° 35' North
Long 18° 04' West

Wednesday June 15th

Wind light from N.E. Blushed Masts.
Saw Grampus, Finbacks, and Porpoises.
Middle and latter part wind moderate.
Saw Grampus. Lat 37° 47' North
Long 19° 40' West

Thursday June 16th

A nice breeze from the East. Saw
Finbacks. Middle and latter part squalls
and dark weather. Saw Porpoises.
Lat 37° 40' North
Long 19° 45' West

Friday June 17th

Dark weather with spots of rain.
Middle and latter part fine weather
and light airs. Saw Finbacks, Grampus
and Porpoises. Saw one sail.
Lat 38° 02' North
Long 20° 31' West

Saturday June 18th

Light airs and calms. Saw Grampus
and Finbacks. Middle and latter
part squalls of rain and wind. Parted
fly fitt pendant and split fly fitt.
Broke out bread, flour, beef, beans,
molasses, and kerosene. Repaired fly
fitt pendants. Lat 38° 04' North
Long 21° 22' West

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Sunday June 19th

Fair weather. Saw five sails. Repaired
fly fitt. Middle and latter part squally.
Saw a steamer. Lat 37° 54' North
Long 21° 51' West

Monday June 20th

Nearly calm with squalls of rain. Saw
Porpoises. Middle and latter part wind
moderate. Lat 38° 05' North
Long 22° 51' West

Tuesday June 21st

Light winds and squalls of rain. Saw
Porpoises. Middle part rainy with light
winds. Latter part wind fresh from the
North. Lat 38° 38' North
Long 24° 12' West

Wednesday June 22nd

Wind fresh from the North. Middle and
latter part moderate. Lighted the Island of
Seceira. Lat 38° 21' North
Long 26° 41' West

Thursday June 23rd

Wind light. Bore new main sheet. Saw
Finback, Porpoise, and other small fry.
Middle and latter part calm. Saw one
sail. Saw lots of small trash. Bore new
fore Peak Halliards. Lat 38° 34' North
Long 26° 40' West

Friday June 24th

Calm. Middle part wind light from
the South. Latter part wind fresh.
Island of Seceira South Dist. 10 miles.

Saturday June 25th

Wind fresh from S.E. Steering between
the Islands of Graciosa and St. George.
Raining. Middle part hard squalls of
rain and wind shifting suddenly about
making a very bad sea. Latter part
calm with heavy swell. Bessel laying
between St. George and Graciosa.
