Strong gales inclining to moderate. Middle and latter part strong winds and rugged water. Turned reef out of foresail.

Tuesday June 28th

Dread gales and rough water. Saw several sails. Middle and latter part strong gales and very rough. Took in fidd and reefed Horesail. Saw one sail.

Wednesday June 29th

Strong gales and rough water. At 6th of the set fidd. Middle and latter part moderate. Made all sail.

Long 32:00 West

Thursday June 30th

Mild light from the West. Saw fish. Middle and latter part light winds and calms. Saw two sails, one Steamer, 2 barkers, Black fish, Porpoises, and fish.

Friday July 1st

Light winds from N.E. Saw one sail. Middle and latter part calms and light airs. Saw one sail. Saw Porpoises and Grampus.

Lat 35:31 North

Long 33:00 West

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Saturday July 2nd

Calms and light airs. Saw Grampus. Middle and latter part fair breeze. Saw one sail.

Long 33:00 West

Sunday July 3rd

Wind fresh from the South. Saw several sails. Middle and latter part fresh winds.

Monday July 4th

Winds moderate, changeable, and squally. Saw beaches but too far away to prove what they were. Middle and latter part squally with shifting winds. Saw one sail.

Lat 35:22 North

Long 37:01 West

Tuesday July 5th

Winds moderate and changeable. Middle and latter part the same. Saw sails

Lat 34:39 North

Long 37:00 West

Wednesday July 6th

Moderate breeze from the West. Reel under all sail. Spoke Steamer Pera of Hull. Saw several sails. Middle and latter part fine breeze from the West. Saw jammers and square head Grampus.

Lat 33:51 North

Long 37:35 West

Thursday July 7th

A fine breeze from the West. Middle and latter part moderate. At 6th of the day saw sperm whales. Lowered in chase. Waist boat struck, killed her whale and took him along side. Starboard boat struck and drew. Starboard boat struck killed her whale and took him along side. Saw Blackfish and killers.
