Saturday October 15th

This Day begins with Squally Weather with Showers at 5:30 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night - middle part a Gale with heavy Sea came up from N.E. and continues through this Day Vessel Hove too under main try Sail so ends this Day

Sunday October 16th

This Day begins with Gale and heavy Sea from N.E. Vessel Hove too under main try Sail with Hatches barred down the remainder of the Day the Gale still continues Vessel Hove too so ends this Day

Monday October 17th

This Day begins with Gale and heavy Sea from N.E. and Vessel Hove too middle part Wind and Sea moderating latter part better Weather made Sail and sent men to the Mast Head so ends this Day

Tuesday October 18th

This Day begins with strong Breeze from the S. Vessel's Head S. at 5:30 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night middle and latter part strong Wind and heavy Sea so ends this Day

Wednesday October 19th

This Day begins with strong Wind and heavy Squalls Wind hauling to the S.W. at 5:30 took in the foresail middle and latter part squally and Rain Wind hauled to the N. so ends this Day

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Thursday October 20th

This Day begins with fine Weather and light northerly Winds at 5:30 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night middle part fine Weather latter part fine weather Crew generally employed in work about the vessel so ends this Day

Friday October 21st

This Day begins with fine clear Weather and northerly Wind at 5:30 shortened Sail for the Night middle and latter part fine clear Weather with N.W. Wind Crew employed in general vessel work so ends this Day

This Day begins with fine clear Weather and N.W. Wind saw a Whaling Schooner but did not speak her, at 5:30 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night middle and latter part strong Wind and rugged Water Crew employed getting out provisions so ends this Day

Sunday October 23rd

This Day begins with strong Wind and heavy swell and Sea middle and latter part fine clear Weather with light East Winds so ends this Day
