This Day begins with fine Weather and smooth Water saw several Sails just after Dark some Black Fish came along side of the Vessel. Middle part strong Breeze latter part Wind freshened into a Gale from the Westward Vessel Hove too so ends this Day

Sunday December 18th

This Day begins with Gale of Wind from the Westward, and Vessel Hove too under Main Torsail and Torsail, close reefed. Middle part Gale of Wind latter part more moderate set the Fore Staysail so ends this Day
