Thursday January 19th

This Day begins with moderate Gale from N.W. Vessel running S by E under short sail middle part strong Wind and rugged sea latter part more moderate set the Foresail and Flying Jib a new one We bent in Port Royal so ends this Day
Lat 30°50' North
Long 77°23' West

Friday January 20th

This Day begins with more moderate Weather set the Fore Saff Topsail saw several sails and some small Fish middle part light Winds latter part a calm saw several Steamships so ends this Day
Lat 29°37' North
Long 75°04' West

Saturday January 21st

This Day begins with a dead calm saw five Pinback middle part Calm latter part good Wind from West crew engaged breaking out Provisions so ends this Day
Lat 29°30' North
Long 74°14' West

Sunday January 22nd

This Day begins with good Breeze from West saw several sails and some small Fish middle part light N.E. Winds latter part light winds passed Ship W. H. Connor of Newport so ends this Day
Lat 29°30' North
Long 72°33' West

Monday January 23rd

This Day begins with light N.E. Winds several sails in sight middle part Calm latter part a dead calm with a heavy swell. Crew engaged sawing and splitting Wood so ends this Day
Lat 30°13' North
Long 72°31' West

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Tuesday January 24th

This Day begins with a calm and quite a heavy swell saw 2 sails and some Dolphin middle part a Breeze sprung up from the S.W. latter part wind shifted suddenly into the N.E. and came up squally so ends this Day
Lat 30°03' North
Long 69°39' West

Wednesday January 25th

This Day begins with squally and Rainy Weather Wind N.E. middle part strong N.E. Wind and rugged sea latter part Wind Hauled into the E. and got very rugged so ends this Day
Lat 30°25' North
Long 69°46' West

Thursday January 26th

This Day begins with strong E Wind and very rugged sea. saw several sails. middle part got a very heavy squall blew away the Fore Staysail latter part gale of wind from the South vessel running under Main Towsail and Jib so ends this Day
Lat 31°00' North
Long 68°10' West

Friday January 27th

This Day begins with gale of wind from S.W. later it hauled into the W.N.W. vessel running under the Main Towsail and Jib heading E by S middle part more moderate latter part still moderating set the Fore sail and Flying Jib so ends this Day
Lat 30°55' North
Long 75°04'
