Friday February 3<sup>rd</sup>

This Day begins with a strong  
Wind with a good deal of Sea  
saw several Salsbury Bottom and  
Timback Whales Middle part very  
Squally with much Rain latter part  
Squally and Rainy wind from N.W.  
so ends this Day Lat 29°35' North  
Long 50°02' West

Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with Rainy Squally  
Weather Wind from N.W. Vessel's Head  
E. by S. Middle part good Breeze from N.  
latter part more moderate with quite  
a swell engaged breaking out  
Provisions saw two Sails so ends  
this Day Lat 29°31' North  
Long 47°46' West

Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with a moderate  
N. Wind and quite a swell. Middle  
part good North Wind and clear  
Weather latter part Wind moderated  
and hauled into the N.E. so ends  
this Day Lat 29°22' North  
Long 45°57' West

Monday February 6<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with moderate  
Wind from E.N.E. Vessel's Head N.  
Middle part Wind from the East and  
very light latter part light Easterly  
Winds Crew engaged at general  
Work so ends this Day Lat 30°13' North  
Long 46°29' West

Tuesday February 7<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with light E Winds  
with clear Weather Middle part light  
Winds latter part light baffling Winds  
from the NE saw several sails and  
one Timback Whale so ends this Day  
Lat 30°16' North  
Long 46°19' West

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Wednesday February 8<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with light baffling  
Winds from the North East saw several  
Timback Whales Middle part light  
Northerly Winds latter part light Winds  
from the North and East Crew employed  
at general work about the Vessel so  
ends this Day Lat 30°12' North  
Long 45°00' West

Thursday February 9<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with light Northerly  
Winds saw Porpoises and several Timback  
Whales Middle part Wind hauled into  
the Nor West a good Breeze latter part  
good Breeze from the Nor West so ends this  
Day Lat 30°39' North  
Long 43°56' West

Friday February 10<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with good Breeze  
from the Nor West Vessel under all  
Sail heading East by South Middle  
part good Breeze and smooth Water latter  
part Wind hauled into the Westward  
Vessel's Head East by South so ends this  
Day Lat 30°46' North  
Long 40°38' West

Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with light West  
Winds Vessel's Head East by South saw  
several Sails and a school of Grampus  
Middle part Westerly Winds latter part  
Westerly Winds and smooth Water  
saw several Sails and Timback Whales  
Crew engaged breaking out Provisions  
so ends this Day Lat 30°50' North  
Long 38°23' West
