This Day begins with fine Weather with North East Wind Vessel's Head West by North saw several sails Middle part fine Weather latter part fine clear Weather with good Breeze Crew engaged breaking out Provisions so ends this Day

This Day begins with strong Wind but smooth Water Middle part strong Wind and rugged Sea latter part strong Breeze with quite a Sea Crew employed at general work so ends this Day

This Day begins with strong Breeze with considerable Sea at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night Middle part strong Wind and rugged latter part strong Breeze with a rugged Sea saw one Timbuck so ends this Day

Thursday March 8th

This Day begins with strong Breeze and rugged Sea at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night Middle part strong Breeze latter part strong Wind and rugged Sea saw a school of Black Fish but new sail for Harvard Boat so ends this Day

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Friday March 9th

This Day begins with strong Breeze and rugged Sea at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night Middle part strong Wind latter part strong Breeze and very rugged so ends this Day

Saturday March 10th

This Day begins with strong Trades and very rugged. spoke Adelia Chase nothing since last report at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night Middle part strong Wind and rugged Sea latter part more moderate Wind but Sea still continues saw a piece of cut Squid. Crew engaged scrubbing the Vessel so ends this Day

Sunday March 11th

This Day begins with moderate Wind but considerable Sea Middle part more moderate latter part less Sea and Wind but very hazy and thick Vessel's Head South. South West so ends this Day

This Day begins with good Breeze but very hazy and thick at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the Night Middle part strong Wind and a good deal of Sea latter part more moderate and Sea going down Crew employed at general work so ends this Day
