This Day begins with good Breeze and considerable Sea and very Hazy Middle part - more moderate and Sea going down latter part - smooth Water and light Wind Vessel's Head South by West - Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

Wednesday March 14th

This Day begins with fine Weather and smooth Water at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the night - Middle part - fine Weather - latter part - fine Weather with smooth Water but - very Hazy Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

Thursday March 15th

This Day begins with moderate Weather and smooth Water saw two schools of Porpoises at 6 P.M. shortened Sail for the night - Middle part - fine light - Weather - latter part - fine Weather with but little Haze took in the Harbor Boat - to repair Her as She was making considerable Water so ends this Day

Friday March 16th

This Day begins with fine Weather and good seeing Middle part - light Weather - latter part - fine Weather and good seeing engaged repairing Harbor Boat - so ends this Day

This Day begins with fine Weather launched the Harbor Boat - and put Her on Her davits again Middle part - Moderate - latter part - Moderate Weather Wind North East - Vessel's Head West - Painted the Harbor Boat - inside and Outside so ends this Day

Sunday March 18th

This Day begins with fine Weather saw two schools of Sigs, and a piece of Cut Squid Middle part - fine Weather - latter part - more Wind and Sea so ends this Day

This Day begins with strong Wind and considerable Sea saw a piece of Squid and a large Turtle Vessel's Head North North West - Wind North East - Middle part - more moderate and Sea going down latter part - strong Wind and considerable Sea Crew employed breaking out Provisions so ends this Day

Tuesday March 20th

This Day begins with moderate Wind but - a good deal of Sea Middle part - more moderate - latter part - Moderate Wind and Sea moderating Wind from North East Vessel's Head North by West - Put out the Cutting Stage so ends this Day
