This Day begins with strong Wind Rain Squalls and heavy Sea Middle Part - Strong Wind Latter Part - strong Wind and rugged Sea so ends this Day Mr. Hutchinson not feeling so well

This Day begins with strong squally Weather and very rugged Sea saw some Humpbacks Middle Part - strong squally Weather Latter Part - Howling almost a Gale with very bad Sea Mr. Hutchinson better so ends this Day

This Day begins with strong Wind and heavy Sea Middle Part - strong Wind Latter Wind and Sea moderating a little saw some small Fish Mr. Hutchinson a little better Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

This Day begins with strong Breeze and rugged Sea Middle Part - Wind and Sea going down Latter Part - moderate Breeze and Sea going down Mr. Hutchinson not so well Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

This Day begins with Wind and sea increasing slightly look in the Flying Jib Middle Part - it moderated to fine clear Weather Latter part fine clear weather made all Sail except the mainsail Mr. Hutchinson the same Crew employed getting out Water so ends this Day

Saturday April 28th

This Day begins with squally Weather coming up and latter it increased so that we put the Vessel under close Reefed Foresail and main topsail Middle Part - moderating Latter Part more moderate set the Jib Mr. Hutchinson better so ends this Day

This Day begins with a good Breeze and considerable Sea Middle Part - more moderate Latter Part - fair weather with rather smooth Water Mr. Hutchinson a little better so ends this Day
