This Day begins with fine clear weather and smooth water vessel under all sail Middle Part Calms and light airs from the Eastward Latter Part light East Wind Vessels Head North Mr. Hutchinson well enough to return to duty Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

This Day begins with a Calm took in the mainsail at 3 P.M. Middle Part Calm Latter Part very light North Wind Vessel's Head West for West Crew engaged at general work so ends this Day

This Day begins with light North Winds Vessel under all sail at 6³⁰ P.M. shortened sail for the night Middle Part light weather Latter Part light North Winds and Calms Wedged up the Rudder Head it having become slightly slack Crew employed at general work so ends this Day

Saturday May 19th

This Day begins with a Calm at 5 P.M. got a light Breeze from the North Middle Part light North Wind Latter Part Calm saw a school of Cow Fish Crew employed at general work so ends this Day

This Day begins with a Calm at 3 P.M. got a light Breeze from the North took a set of Lunar's Middle Part light Winds Latter Part Calm so ends this Day

This Day begins with a light Wind from the Northward saw several Humpbacks Middle Part light Winds saw two Steamers Men of War Latter Part light Winds from the North passed two pieces of Wreck stuff caught a few Fish Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

Tuesday May 22nd

This Day begins with fine clear weather and light North Wind Middle Part light North Wind Latter Part Calm with a North Wind swell Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

This Day begins with a Calm at 3 P.M. got a light North East Wind Middle Part fine weather with light North East Wind Latter Part light East North E Wind made all sail saw two Vessels and some Drift stuff Crew engaged breaking out provisions so ends this Day
