This Day begins with very light South Wind saw one Sail Middle Part Calm Weather latter Part light South East Wind saw considerable Drift stuff and Porpoises and Grampus and the Water looks good M^r. Worth better Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Sunday June 17th

This Day begins with light Winds from the Southward and Eastward Middle Part Calm latter Part very light Winds from the South saw some Grampus so ends this Day

Monday June 18th

This Day begins with very light South Winds saw some Porpoises Middle Part Calm latter Part very light South Winds M^r. Worth better saw some Porpoises Crew engaged setting up some of the Head Gear so ends this Day

Tuesday June 19th

This Day begins with very light South Winds saw Grampus and Porpoises and some Drift stuff Middle Part light South Winds latter Part Wind hauled into the Westward saw several Vessels bound South saw Grampus and some drift stuff M^r. Worth better Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

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Wednesday June 20th

This Day begins with South West Wind and smooth Water saw Grampus breaching Middle Part fine Weather latter Part fine clear Weather with good Southerly Wind M^r. Worth the same Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Thursday June 21st

This Day begins with good southerly Wind and fine Weather saw some cut Squid Middle Part fine Weather latter Part strong Breeze from the Southward Vessels Head West saw one Sail found to the Eastward M^r. Worth the same Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Friday June 22nd

This Day begins with strong Breeze from the Southward and a good deal of Sea saw several Hump Back Middle Part strong Breeze latter Part strong southerly Wind and rugged Water M^r. Worth the same so ends this Day

Saturday June 23rd

This Day begins with strong Breeze from the South and very Rainy and squally Middle Part squally latter Part Wind hauled into the Westward with Rainy squally Weather M^r. Worth the same Crew engaged breaking out provisions so ends this Day
