This Day begins with Rainy squally Weather with Westerly Wind Vessels Head South by West Middle Part fine Weather Latter Part Wind hauled into the North West with fine clear Weather M<sup>r</sup> Worth improving slowly so ends this Day Lat 30° 01' North

Monday June 25<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with fine clear Weather and North West Wind saw Grampus Middle Part fine Weather Latter Part fine clear Weather M<sup>r</sup> Worth improving Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Lat 29° 10' North

Long 49° 36' West

Tuesday June 26<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with fine clear Weather with North West Wind Sailed the Adelia Phoebe who was hauling a large Whale having taken 18<sup>th</sup> since leaving Barbados Middle Part Calm Latter Part light North Winds saw several schools of Grampus M<sup>r</sup> Worth improving Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Wednesday June 27<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with very light North Wind saw Grampus Middle Part Calm Latter Part Calm M<sup>r</sup> Worth improving slowly Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Lat 29° 18' North

Long 49° 38' West

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Thursday June 28<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with a Calm some small fish around the Vessel Middle Part Calm Latter Part got a light West Wind and made all sail Vessels Head North North West saw one sail M<sup>r</sup> Worth the same Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day Lat 29° 50' North

Long 49° 48' West

Friday June 29<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with fine Weather with good Westerly Wind saw Grampus Middle Part fine Weather Latter Part strong Westerly Wind and a good deal of sea were around to the southward. M<sup>r</sup> Worth the same Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day Lat 30° 26' North

Long 50° 33' West

Saturday June 30<sup>th</sup>

This Day begins with strong Westerly Wind and quite a sea saw two sails bound South Middle Part strong Breeze Latter Part strong Breeze and quite a sea saw a Steamship bound West M<sup>r</sup> Worth the same Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day Lat 29° 53' North

Long 50° 48' West

Sunday July 1<sup>st</sup>

This Day begins with strong breeze and considerable sea Sailed the Mary E. Simmons 578<sup>th</sup> Spinn all fold spoke the Baltic clear Middle Part strong Westerly Wind Latter Part strong Westerly Wind Vessels Head East South East M<sup>r</sup> Worth the same so ends this Day
