Wednesday August 15th

This Day begins with fine Weather all hands engaged clearing the Hole and scraping covermasts being a holiday could get no Casks from shore so ends this Day

Thursday August 16th

This Day begins with fine Weather started to paint outside but it came up rainy and had to stop so ends this Day

Friday August 17th

This Day begins with fine Weather but strong Wind from the Westward Painted the Vessel outside Walter Nichols better so ends this Day

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Saturday August 18th

This Day begins with Very Raining squally Weather with Gale from the Westward got off one raft of new Casks full of fresh Water so ends this Day

Sunday August 19th

This Day begins with fine Weather but latter came up squally and Raining let the Port Watch go ashore remained rainy all Day so ends this Day

Monday August 20th

This Day begins with squally Weather started to stow off the Hole and fill with Fresh Water got off the rest of the rest of the shook Casks full of Fresh Water so ends this Day

Tuesday August 21st

This Day begins with squally Weather engaged stowing the Hole Starboard Watch ashore on Liberty engaged stowing the Hole so ends this Day

Wednesday August 22nd

This Day begins with better Weather Port watch on Liberty engaged stowing the Hole with fresh Water Starboard mate returned aboard from the Hospital
