Tuesday September 18th

This Day begins with Gale moderating at 12:30 P.M. came to the Wind and laid under close reefed Foreail Middle Part more moderate latter Part still moderating and Sea going down fast made all Sail, except the Mainsail spliced the Fore Stay and set it up Wind North North East Vessel on the Eastern tack Mr Hutchings better Crew engaged at General Work so ends this Day

Wednesday September 19th

This Day begins with fine clear Weather and smooth Water saw several Sails bound South Middle Part fine Weather latter Part fine clear Weather Wind from the North Vessel on the Eastern tack saw Porpoises Mr Hutchings returned to duty Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Thursday September 20th

This Day begins with fine clear Weather saw several Sails bound South Middle Part fine clear Weather latter Part fine Weather with Northerly Wind Vessels Head South Crew engaged at general work so ends this Day

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Friday September 21st

This Day begins with fine clear Weather and light North Wind at Vessels Head South at 6 P.M. luffed to the Wind on Port Tack saw two Sails bound South Middle Part Calm with Rain latter Part light North Winds and Calm Vessels Head South East saw Grampus and Porpoises Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

Saturday September 22nd

This Day begins with light clear Weather at 6 P.M. took in the Foreail and let the Vessel luff to the Wind put in a new Gangway Rail to replace the one lost in the Hurricane Middle Part Calm with Rain latter Part Calm and light south Wind's Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

Sunday September 23rd

This Day begins with very light South Wind's Barometer broke down at 6 P.M. shortened sail for the night Middle Part squally Rainy Weather latter Part strong South Wind Vessel on the Eastern tack saw several Sails bound East so ends this Day
