This Day begins with strong Trades and rugged sea at 4 P.M. raised the West Point of Saint Antonio distant - 10 miles very thick and Hazy at sundown were slip off shore Middle Part - strong Trades Latter Part - fresh Trades at 4 A.M. were around and headed for the Land Walter Nichols better Joe Gibbon the same Crew engaged at general Work so ends this Day

This Day begins with light weather Vessel close to the Land and heading to the Southward Middle Part - calm and light Westerly Winds Latter Part - calm and light Trades Vessel's Head South by East - Walter Nichols returned to Duty Joe Gibbon the same so ends this Day
