This Day begins with moderate Trades and smooth Water 4 P.M. filed over and Headed West by South middle part fine Weather at 10 P.M. raised Ragged Total Light on Barbadoes at 4 2. M. Kept off for the Port at 10 a.m. anchored in the Port so ends this Day

Friday January 32nd

This Day begins with fine clear Weather broke out the Oil and sent it ashore so ends this Day

Saturday February 2nd

This Day begins with fine clear Weather engaged slowing back the Hole and paulling so ends this Day

Sunday February 3rd

This Day begins with fine Weather let all Halls go ashore all returned at Sundown so ends this Day

Monday February 4th

This Day begins with fine Weather took Water and Paulled the Vessel outside so ends this Day

Tuesday February 5th

This Day begins with fine Weather Starboard Watch ashore on Liberty Richard Anderson and Robert Haddock deserted so ends this Day

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Wednesday February 6th

This Day begins with fine Weather Port Watch ashore on Liberty Walter Nichols and Charles Frager deserted so ends this Day

Thursday February 7th

This Day begins with fine Weather Starboard Watch ashore on Liberty all returned aboard got of provisions and empty B^{ls} so ends this Day

Friday February 8th

This Day begins with fine Weather Port Watch ashore on Liberty Herman Janslooke not being shipped in the Vessel went ashore of his own free Will so ends this Day 5 new men came aboard

Saturday February 9th

This Day begins with fine clear Weather finished slowing the Hole and got ready for Sea so ends this Day

Sunday February 10th

This Day begins with fine Weather and light Trades at 8 a.m. got under weigh and steered up the Coast at 11 a.m. allowed the starboard Boat with 1st and 3rd Mates to go ashore the returned aboard at 3 P.M. very light Trades during the middle and latter part so ends this Day
