and started to trade so ends this
Day

This Day begins with fine Weather
got off two Rafts of Water a
Prussian Man of War anchored
in the Bay so ends this Day

Friday February 15th

This Day begins with squally Weather
engaged trading and getting off Wood
and Water so ends this Day

Saturday February 16th

This Day begins with squally Weather
got off Water and Wood Jakes Doreau
had to be put in Irons and kept there
for two hours on account of disorderly
conduct so ends this Day

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Sunday February 17th

This Day begins with fine Weather
let all Hands go ashore to Church
all returned aboard so ends this
Day

Monday February 18th

This Day begins with Rainy and
squally Weather got off all the Wood
and Water so ends this Day Elliott
Martin deserted

Tuesday February 19th

This Day begins with fine Weather
stowed off the Hole and got all
ready for Sea so ends this Day

Wednesday February 20th

This Day begins with strong Trades
at 8 A.M. took the Anchor and
proceeded to Sea steering West
stowed the Anchors and Cable so
ends this Day
