Friday March 1st
This Day begins with fresh Trades
saw a large school of Black Fish
at sundown shortened sail for
the night middle part fresh Trades
latter part strong Trades and
rugged at daylight raised the
sail of Sandozings saw a
Peruvian Bark Crew engaged at
general Work so ends this Day
Lat 18° 50 North
Long 70° 28 West

Saturday March 2nd

This Day begins with strong
Trades and rugged Sea Vessel
Heading along the Shore to the
Westward at sundown luffed to
the Wind on Southern Tack middle
part fresh Trades middle part
strong Trades latter part strong
Trades and rugged Sea Vessel
Running along the Shore Crew
employed at general Work so
ends this Day

Lat 17° 34 North
Long 71° 40 West

Sunday March 3rd

This Day begins with strong Trades
and Rugged Sea Run down the
Coast to Lane Bay at sundown
luffed to the Wind on the off
Shore middle part more moderate
latter part moderate Trades and
smooth Water spoke the Baltic
at Quebor 120th Sperm since
leaving Port so ends this Day

Lat Off and on
Long at Lane Bay

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Monday March 4th
This Day begins with light Trades
saw Grampus middle part light
land Breeze latter part light
Trades saw the schooner's Golden
City and Franklin Crew engaged
at general Work so ends this Day
Lat Off and on
Long in Lane Bay

Tuesday March 5th

This Day begins with light Trades
saw Grampus middle part Calm
latter part Calm some small Fish
around the Vessel Crew employed
at general Work so ends this Day
Lat 18° 00 North
Long 71° 57 West

Wednesday March 6th

This Day begins with a Calm
saw one Coasting Schooner and
a school of Grampus middle part
Calm latter part light land
Breeze gained the Golden City
170th Sperm all told reports the
Franklin 370th Sperm all told
Crew engaged at general Work
so ends this Day

Lat Off and on
Long in Lane Bay

Thursday March 7th

This Day begins with light West
Wind Vessel Heading off Shore
middle part Calm carried away
the foresail latter part Calm
engaged repairing the foresail
so ends this Day
