Wednesday March 20th

This Day begins with heavy squally Weather with Thunder and lightning and much Rain. Middle part moderate Gale Vessel. Here too latter part Gale moderating so ends this Day.

Thursday March 21st

This Day begins with more moderate Weather made some sail Wind hauling into the North West Middle part fine Weather latter part fine Clear Weather saw one sail Wind from the North Vessels Head West. Crew engaged at general Work for. Sailed the same so ends this Day.

Friday March 22nd

This Day begins with moderate North Wind Vessels Head West Middle part fine Weather Wind hauled into the North East Vessels Head West latter part moderate Trades Vessels Head North West sighted the Isle of Pines and ran down along the shore Crew engaged getting out Provisions for Sailed the same so ends this Day.

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Saturday March 23rd

This Day begins with moderate Trades Vessel running down the Coast saw several large Green Turtles and two sails at sundown hauled aback on off shore Tack Middle part fine Weather latter part fresh Trades Vessels heading to the Westward along the Coast Mr. Hutchingson off Duty Sick. Joe Sailed the same Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day.

Sunday March 24th

This Day begins with strong Trades and rugged Water Vessels Head West by South at sundown shortened sail and luffed for on the Port Tack saw one sail Middle part fresh Trades at 1 A.M. kept off heading West latter part Variable Winds with Rain squalls Joe Sailed the same Mr. Hutchingson better so ends this Day.

Monday March 25th

This Day begins with Variable Winds and heavy Rain squalls saw several sails Middle part Variable light Winds with a good deal of sea latter part strong North West Wind Vessel on the northern Tack saw the Land and light House on Cape San Antonio Cuba 11:30 A.M. luffed off shore so ends this Day.
