Monday April 1st

This day begins with more moderate
Breeze from East South East
Vessel Heading North East saw
several Sails Middle part moderate
South Winds latter part Wind
from South West Vessels Head
South South East Mr Worth no better
Joe Seneca the same Crew engaged
at general Work so ends this
day Lat 26°40' North
Long 84°29' West

Tuesday April 2nd

This day begins with light-
Westerly Winds Vessels Head South
South East Middle part wind
hauled into the North West
latter part light Winds from
North West to North East Vessels
Head South South East Mr Worth
the same Joe Seneca the same
Crew employed at general
Work so ends this day
Lat 26°29' North
Long 84°37' West

Wednesday April 3rd

This day begins with light North
East Wind Vessels Head South
East Middle part Wind hauled
in the South East Vessels Head
South South West latter part at
Sunrise Wm arrived on the
Northern Tack at 10 A.M. Wind
hauled Wm around heading South
South East Mr Worth and Joe Seneca
better. Crew engaged at general Work
so ends this day

Lat 25°28' North
Long 84°12' West

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Thursday April 4th

This day begins with light Trades
Vessels Head South South East at
4 P.M. Came up squally and Raining
from North West Middle part light
Winds and Rain squalls
from North and latter part Calms
at 9 A.M. got a heavy squall from
the North West with heavy Rain
Vessels Head South East with strong
North Wind and Rain Mr Worth
and Joe Seneca better Crew engaged
at general Work so ends this day
Lat No Obs.
Long No Obs.

Friday April 5th

This day begins with strong
North East Wind and heavy Rain
flew away 2 cloths in the Foresail
Vessels Head East South East.
Middle part squally and Raining
latter part fresh North Wind
and Clear required the Foresail
Vessels Head East Crew engaged at
general Work Joe Seneca returned to
Duty Mr Worth better so ends
this day Lat 24°00' North
Long 81°25' West

Saturday April 6th

This day begins with North and
North East Wind Vessel making
East North East Middle part fine
Weather with light Variable Winds
from the North and latter part
light Variable Wind from the
North Mr Worth better. Crew engaged
breaking out provisions saw
a good many Sails so ends
this day Lat 24°32' North
Long 80°06' West
