This Day begins with light Variable Winds saw two Sails bound North at sundown shortened Sail for the night Middle part fine Weather with Easterly Wind latter part fine clear Weather with Easterly Wind Vessel Head West North West saw a great many Porpoises and small Fish and considerable drift stuff sent in the Flying Jib and started to repair it saw two Sails bound North so ends this Day

This Day begins with fine clear Weather finished the Flying Jib and put it again shortened Sail for the night luffed to the Wind on the Southern Tack Wind from the Eastward Middle part fine Weather latter part fine clear Weather with wind from the Eastward Vessel on the Southern Tack saw porpoises and plenty of Birds and small Fish Crew employed at general Work so ends this Day

This Day begins with fine Weather and Easterly Wind at sundown shortened Sail Middle part Wind increased to strong breeze latter part increased to small Gale Wind hauled to North West Verry rugged Vessel here too so ends this Day
