This Day begins with light South. Winds Vessel's Head North at 5:15 raised a school of mixed Whales at 5:30 lowered the Boats and chased to leeward as the Boats were coming aboard after sundown the Waist Boat went on and fastened starboard Boat struck same Whale the Mate shot a Bomb and killed the Whale in 20 minutes got him fast alongside at 8:30 Mr. Hutchinson off duty sick Middle part fine Weather latter part fine Weather got up the Cutting Gear and started to cut got off the Head and took in the Body so ends this Day

Monday May 27th

This Day begins with fine Weather took in the Head and Baled the Case Mr. Hutchinson no better troubled greatly with Piles Wind from the South West Vessel on the Southern Tack at 6 P.M. started the Works Middle part fine clear Weather latter part fine clear Weather with Southerly Wind Vessel on the Northern Tack finished the Boiling the Head and started on the Body so ends this Day

Tuesday May 28th

Whales
Off Bow

This Day begins with fine clear Weather Vessel on the Southern Tack stowed down the Head Oil Middle part fine Weather latter part fine Weather finished Boiling at 3 a.m. stowed down part of the Body Oil at 10 a.m. Raised a School of mixed Whales at 10:30 lowered all the Boats at 11:20 starboard Boat went on and fastened Whale stove the Boat badly starboard Boat took the line and in trying to Boat him got stove slightly Mate went into the Waist Boat and killed the Whale with a Bomb so ends this Day. Whale was a fighting Whale

Wednesday May 29th

This Day begins with fine Weather got the Whale fast alongside and picked up the stove Boats stowed down the rest of the Oil and got up the Cutting Gear and set the Walrus Mr. Hutchinson returned to duty Middle part fine Weather latter part light Southerly Winds at 4 a.m. hooked on to the Whale and started to cut got off the Head and took in part of the Body so ends this Day
