

Aug 26th Lat 35.53^N Long 37.53^W
Light breeze settled in
Steamer Gouise S.E. planked
Grampas porpoise & fish
so ends this day

" 27th Lat 35.28^N Long 37.24^W Stiff W.
breeze sighted two Boats plenty
of Grampas so ends this day

" 28th Lat 34.38^N Long 36.23^W Strong
breeze steering S.E. squally
in afternoon so ends this day

" 29th Lat 34.05^N Long 35.49^W
Light breeze steering S.E.
Mate raised a large white
whale on his beam we
towards it but could not
come up with it so ends this day

" 30th Lat 34.05 Long 35.29 Light breeze
all day steering N so ends this day

" 31st Lat 34.21 Long 35.37 Light breeze
all day one sail in sight
John Monton raised a white
whale ahead just after noon
S.M. turned out to be four
large whales, bowers and
chased nearly all day but did
not get fast. Whales were going
very fast headed S.W.
so ends this day & month

Sept 1st

Lat 34.47 Long 35.45 Calm all day
three sails in sight Mate raised
a large white whale could
not get up to it so ends this day

" 2nd Lat 35.06 Long 35.45 Very light
breeze Calm raised a large
white whale but could not
make it out four sails in
sight caught about 40 Albacore
hove out water so ends this day

" 3rd Lat 35.42 Long 35.33 Good breeze
all day S.W. several sails in
sight saw several large white
whales but could not make them
out Mate struck a large hammer
head shark this P.M.
so ends this day

" 4th Lat 36.20 Long 34.54 Light
breeze steering E.N.E. saw
several schools of Grampas
squalls in afternoon
so ends this day

" 5th Lat 36.35 Long 33.20 Strong Breeze
from N.E. two sails in sight
saw several small breaches
this A.M. caught 80 Albacore
& four Dolphins
so ends this day

" 6th Lat 36.03 Lat 33.11 Strong breeze
made a more towards Port than
& second mate took the watches
again heading N.E. so ends this day
