

Sept 7th Lat 31.04 Long 33.22 Moderate breeze from East sighted a Steamer so ends this day

" 8th Lat 38.22 Long 33.21 Moderate breeze Easterly heading N.E. so ends this day

9th Lat 38.44 Long 33.01 Light East wind heading S sighted a steamer so ends this day

10th Lat 38.10 Long 32.52 Strong Breeze in A.M. Calm in P.M. Antoine Mate's boatsterere had a fit Peter second mate fish driver raised a large school of very small whales early in the morning going to windward did not get fast in the afternoon Mate raised a large school of large whales & small mixed second mate struck a small one cut him in later so ends this day

11th Lat 38.16 Long 32.49 Calm most all day started the morning large sword fish around the ship so ends this day

12th Lat 38.10 Long 32.12 finished trying out Peter raised whales found & chased all the forenoon George & Mary chased same whales boats spoke her no whales caught so ends this day

stormed down in afternoon 1/10/88

Sept 13th Lat 38.06 Long 31.27 Light breeze S steering E.S.E. two sail in sight so ends this day

" 14th Lat 38.14 Long 29.19 strong breeze S.W. steering E. one sail in sight expect to sight land tomorrow so ends this day

" 15th Lat 38.16 Long 27.58 Strong northerly wind Mate sighted Hayal at three o'clock P.M. steering up under the lee of the land will try to go in tomorrow so ends this day

16th Took a pilot about 3 o'clock. Came to Anchor about four o'clock so ends this day

17th Sent Water Casks ashore also mainsail & Deck and Bag scraped for it mail masts so ends this day

18th Sunday one watch a shore so ends this day

19th Broke out Oil & sent it ashore 15 Casks so ends this day

20th Broke out the rest of the oil & sent it ashore took 190 lbs. Blakes oil turned out 190 lbs so ends this day

21st Took Water on board and some other provisions stored down water
