

22nd scraped masts and booms - and oiled same and other small jobs so ends this day

23rd Took wood & water sent S. B. ashore to be repaired starboard watch on liberty so ends this day

24th Starboard watch ashore on liberty stowed down wood & water so ends this day

25th Starboard watch came on board 3 sailors - minus Johny Alves.

Manoel Latch Dennis Monteiro S.B. watch run ashore Joe Fernandez Antongony finished stowing down got Bedson back and every thing straightened up for sea so ends this day

27th Sawed & split wood & stowed down same and worked on rigging so ends this day

28th Worked on rigging & and other odd jobs so ends this day

29th Sailed from Fayal about 1 P.M. Capt stayed ashore Mate layed off & on Capt came on board just before dark brought five new men moderate breeze from W.S.W. steering South so ends this day

30th Lat 37.23 Long 29.20 Light W. wind steering S. E. been getting boats & whaling gear in order so ends this day & month

Oct 1st Lat 36.50 Long 25.10 light W. wind course S. E. sighted the Is of St. Marks - this morning ran down past it and regulated the chronometer boatsteerer head the watches tonight so ends - this day

2nd Lat 34.14 Long 24.00 Strong W. wind sighted a spot to windward late could not make it out so ends this day

3rd Lat 35.32 Long gone Strong W. S. W. wind with heavy rain squalls - Peter second mate boatsteerer sick second mate heads his watch tonight so ends this day

4th Lat 34.05 - Long 22.35 Strong breeze N. N. W. steering S sighted two Barks & one Steamer broke out the clothing cash & supplies the wants of the new men so ends this day

5th Lat 32.34 Long 21.09 Strong breeze from N. E. laying under short sail so ends this day

6th Lat 32.05 - Long 20.17 Calm nearly all day two sail in sight so ends this day

7th Lat 31.48 Long gone Calm all day painting S. B. so ends this day

8th Lat 31.30 Long 19.15 Very light breeze several sail in sight so ends this day
