Lat 18.50 Long none Calm saw Grampus
& Porpoise so ends this day

" 2nd

Lat 19.05 Long 26.19 Calm all day
saw Grampus so ends this day

" 3rd

Lat 19.08 Long 25.26 Strong breeze
three whales in sight raised
a whale breaching mated with
the George & Mary latter boat
struck mate & boatswain on
board in afternoon to help cut
in of the Albion Chase so ends this day

" 4th

Lat 19.23 Long 25.12 had a very severe
storm in the latter part of
the night with thunder &
lightning with very heavy
sea running was laying to
under close reef foresail &
trysail tried the pumps & found
her leaking 30 strokes per hour
took the head & carcass from
the George & Mary tonight
so ends this day

" 5th

Lat none Long ditto Strong breeze
W. rough cut off the head &
cut in the small of whale
so ends this day

" 6th

Lat 19.30 Long 24.13 Strong breeze
& very rough lost the head
from along side tried out
the small got about ten lbs.
Antoni Dandao - had a fit
this afternoon so ends this day

Jan 7th

Lat 19.12 Long 23.53 Strong breeze
far enough sea one steamer in
sight one ech decided oil
with George & Mary 24 bts each
Antoni Dandao - had two
fits during the night so ends this day

" 8th

Lat 19.06 Long 23.17 Strong breeze
Course S.E. by E sighted one
steamer and one bark
so ends this day

" 9th

Lat 18.14 Long 22.07 Light breeze
sighted one steamer
so ends this day

" 10th

Lat 18.15 Long 21.43 Moderate breeze
Mate raised whales breaching on
weather beam hooked up
to them and hauled just before
L.B. went on boatswain had a
fit & fell overboard got him
into the boat but he soon had
another which lasted nearly an
hour when he came out of
it carried him onto a whale
but he missed got a second
chance but he missed again
slacked off & second mate
went on & struck then L.B.
went on and struck landed
a loose whale saved both
second mate saved his
thick the three will make
45 or 50 lbs - one sail in sight
cut in one whale
so ends this day
